**RE: ORDINANCE REMOVING THE STATE'S ATTORNEY AS THE
COUNTY ETHICS ADVISOR**

WHEREAS, the County Board of Kankakee County believes it is in the best interest of the citizens of Kankakee County to pass an ordinance that will allow for an independently appointed county ethics advisor; and,


WHEREAS, Section 2-229, sub-section (c), of the Kankakee County Code currently designates the Kankakee County State's Attorney as the County Ethics Advisor; and,

WHEREAS, this ordinance amendment is necessary to avoid any actual or perceived conflicts of interest in having the State's Attorney provide advice that could impact County Departments adversely; and,

WHEREAS, at the Executive Committee Meeting on June 27, 2017, after review, discussion and consideration, the committee recommended the deletion of sub-section (c) of Section 2-229 of the Kankakee County Code.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Kankakee County Board that Section 2-229, sub-section (c) of the Kankakee County Code be deleted.
